

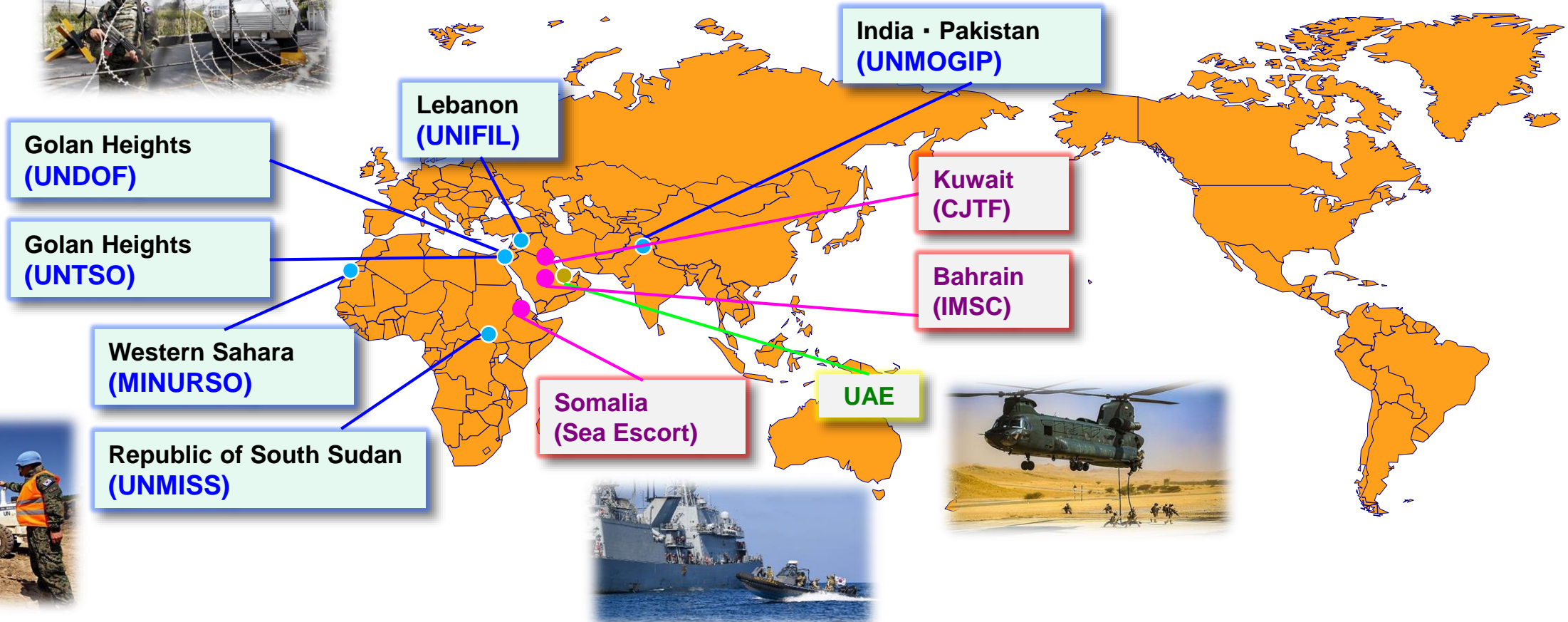

# Current Status of ROK Overseas Deployment



- ✓ **UN PKO**(●) : 566 personnel (individual : 26 / unit : 540)
- ✓ **Multi-national Forces(MNF)** (●) : 280 personnel (individual : 16 / unit : 264)
- ✓ **Defense Cooperation** (●) : 146 troops ( Akh Unit in U.A.E.)

\* Total: 992 personnel

\* **ROK PKO Center** is located in KNDU (**K**orea **N**ational **D**efense **U**niversity)

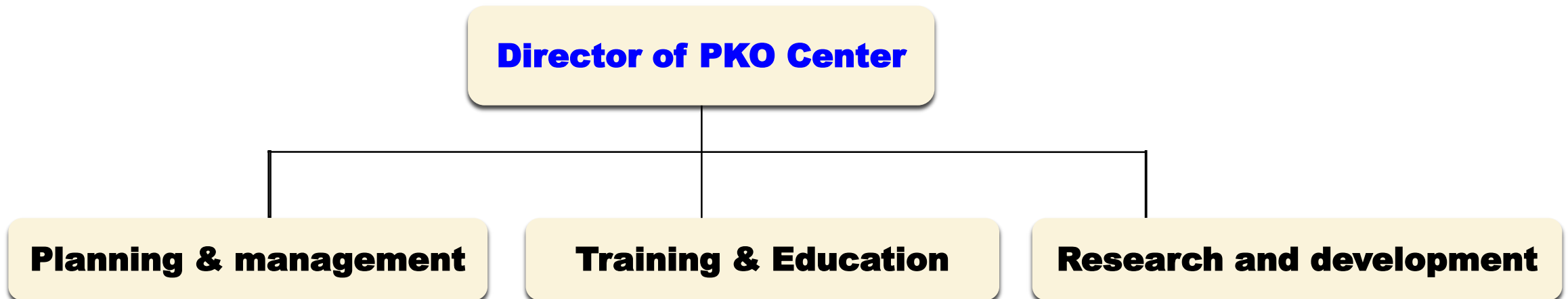

# Pre-deployment training for individuals & units (1/3)

**About 2,000 trainees from 17 courses throughout the year**

\* **UN PKO(UNMO • UNSOC)**, MNF, Defense cooperation etc.

**Train soldiers to be prepared for mission upon arrival**

- Improve capability in conducting operations
- Train with updated UN guidelines and doctrine

## Research on PKO and Conflict Areas

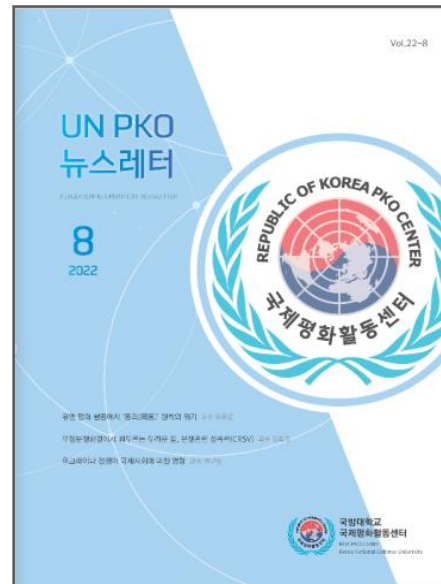
- Translate and Publish Essential UN documents

## □ Publish After-Mission Report and periodical publication

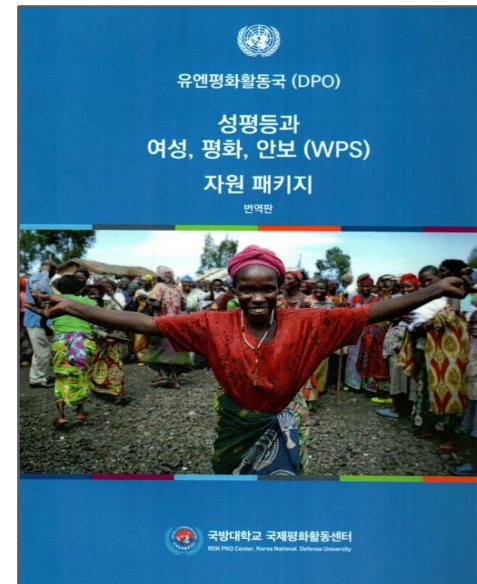
- Supervise and manage After Mission Report

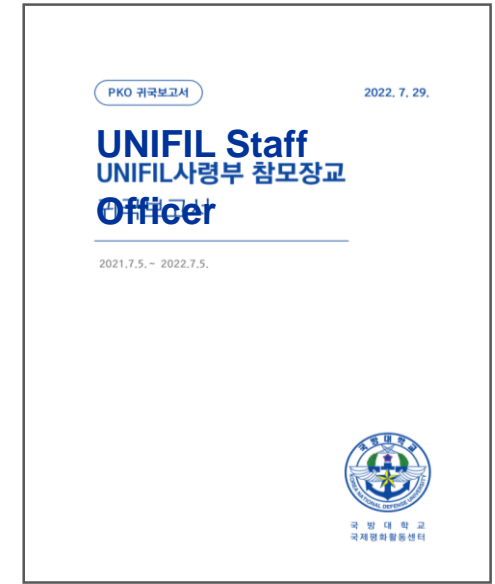

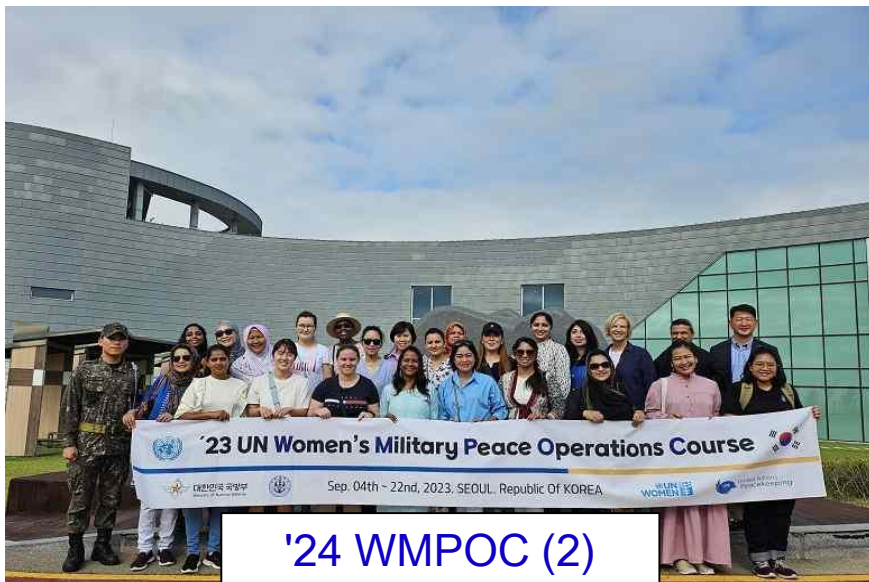
