The Special Committee calls upon the Secretariat to continue to make full use of the light coordination mechanism structure to **encourage increased information-sharing and direct coordination between military and police capacity builders and recipients** to eliminate redundancy and focus efforts, and to facilitate training partnerships. 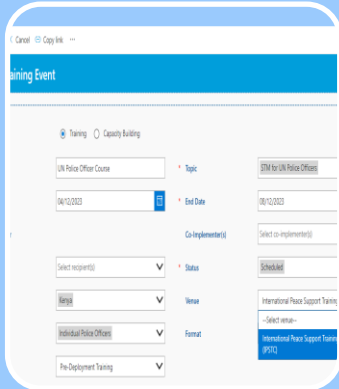

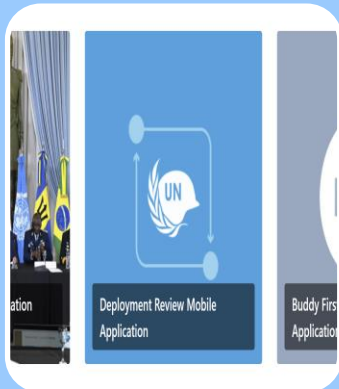

LCM Online System – Main Functions

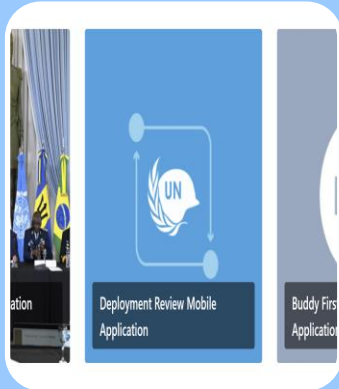


24/7 Online platform created for Member States to **securely** consolidate all their military and police peacekeeping-related training activities

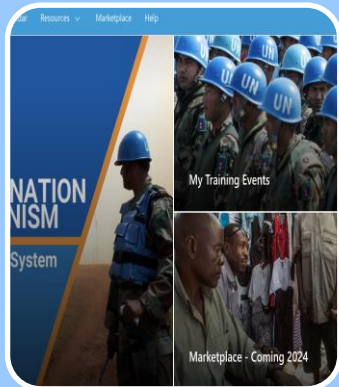


Information uploaded by MS enables the LCM to observe peacekeeping training capacities and partnership trends and to identify future opportunities for cooperation

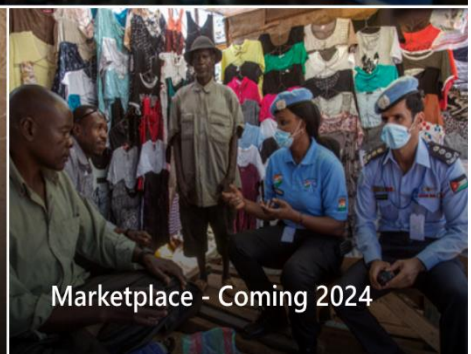

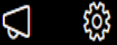

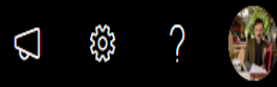

LCM Online System – Conflict Rules

Same date range + same location +

a) same audience, or

b) same topic + same format

=> triggers a conflict between two events

LCM Online System – Sharing of training events

- Events are automatically shared with co-implementers and recipients (read-only)
- Events can be shared with additional interested partners (read-only) on a case-by-case basis

Coming in June 2024: LCM Online System – Marketplace

- Main function: Encourages information-sharing, collaboration and burden-sharing between Member States
- Users of the LCMOS can post training offers and requests (“in search of...”) such as training courses, trainers, venues
- Overview of listings can be filtered and searched according to date, location, audience, topic
- Member States can directly engage with each other on offers

The Buddy First Aid Mobile Application



The Buddy First Aid Mobile Application

- Supplements the UNBFAC training by providing instant access to first aid guidance for those facing crisis situations on the front line, with no internet connection required.
- Includes step-by-step protocol for the delivery of first aid in line with the MARCH methodology (M-massive bleeding, R-respiration, C-circulation, H-heat/cold).
- When used properly in the field, the app can save lives and increase the survivability of the injured.
